Event Description

This classroom field-trip event series is designed to introduce, highlight and reinforce student's understanding of the important contributions made to Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) by African-Americans. Presented by Grand Hank, an internationally renowned, successful African-American scientist. Grand Hank is a STEM presenter, curriculum designer, and former host of the "Science Lab of Grand Hank" and co-host of the "Science of Philadelphia" television series, which are aired on PSTV and Mind-TV through the Comcast Cable Network.

The event series consists of live science demonstrations, where each lesson features a biographical look at an African-American scientist and/or inventor who influenced the science behind the experiment.
